# **Winter Uniform**

### The winter uniform needs to be worn from Tuesday 03<sup>rd</sup> May 2022.

Please parents, there will be zero tolerance if the incorrect uniform is worn. Attached please find the list which allows you adequate time to purchase the correct winter uniform.

The only change to this list for the High School is that the girls and boys may wear short sleeve white shirts with a hard collar for the tie to be worn correctly. Thank you for your support. **NB!!!! Please ensure that everything is labelled**.

### PRIMARY SCHOOL

**Boys**: Full tracksuits may be worn or long black trousers together with a short sleeved white shirt with school badge and tracksuit top / bottle green V-neck jersey.

**Girls**: 6 panel bottle green skirt with their same blouse with school badge on pocket. Girls may wear the full tracksuit with a jersey or their skirt together with the tracksuit top / jersey. If a skirt is worn, long black socks may be worn instead of the short white socks.

School Bags: Official Wendon Academy School and Sports Bags. NO other bags are allowed.

Sports Kits: Black baggies (purchase anywhere – no branding, stripes etc.), or bottle green shorts from Gem Schoolwear, White golf shirt, Wendon Academy Tracksuit. Bottle green floppy sun hat. Plain dark coloured takkies.

## HIGH SCHOOL - (GRADE 8, 9, 10, 11 AND 12)

**Boys**: Short sleeve white shirts with stiff collar (no badge) with long black trousers. Bottle green blazer with badge on pocket, Demani Tie and bottle green V-neck jersey. (See Grade 12 below)

**Girls**: Short sleeve white shirts with stiff collar (no badge) with their 6 panel bottle green skirt and black stockings or long black socks. Bottle green blazer with badge on pocket, Demani Tie and bottle green V-neck jersey. (See Grade 12 below)

The tracksuit may only be worn for sport if needed. If cold, the seniors have a bottle green V-necked jersey and blazer to wear, <u>NO</u> tracksuit tops or jerseys may be worn to school on their own. Blazers are to be worn to school and then back home.

School Bags: Official Wendon Academy School and Sports Bags.

Sports Kits: Black baggies (purchase anywhere - no branding, stripes etc.), or green shorts from Gem Schoolwear, White golf shirt, Wendon Academy Tracksuit. Plain dark coloured takkies.
