To the awesome staff of Wendon Academy, we thank you for pulling out all the stops and going the extra mile to ensure our pupils completed their full 2020 academic year.

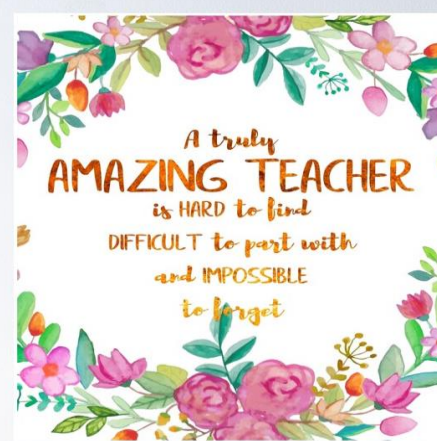
