

The school year of 2020 has almost come to an end and this will be the last "Eagle's Nest" until 2021.


Parents, the Prize Giving is extremely important to attend. This is where we honour your children for the progress they have made throughout the year.


Due to the lockdown levels changing we can accommodate more classes together allowing for added excitement for each class as they receive their rewards. Prize giving will be over 2 days.
