'GIFT OF FRIENDS' - BREAK UP DAY - 16TH SEPTEMBER - CIVVIES & PANCAKES - R20

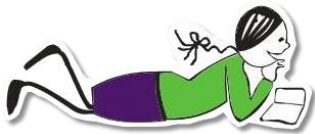

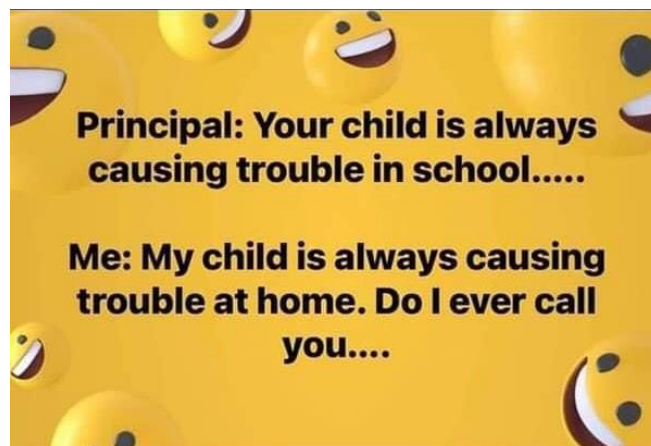
